Launched in 1924 for service on Thames estuary routes. She was used as a minesweeper in WWII and is famous for her seven trips to Dunkirk in 1940. She returned to her old route until 1963, after which she was a nightclub in the Isle of Wight. The ship was returned to the river Medway in 1984 and her hull has now been rebuilt
